\$360,000. Police and FBI investigation soon apprehended four suspects: Christopher Butler, Lisa Ramirez, Christopher Huggins, and Robert Ortiz. But investigators were suspicious that Michelle had been involved in the robbery -- the dynamite had turned out to be fake; she had claimed that she had recognized one of the masked robbers as a customer, even though he had been in her bank only once; and she herself had filed for bankruptcy - for the second time - only a month before the robbery. However, no proof was ever discovered to confirm this suspicion. Eighteen months later, Butler and Ramirez went on trial. Ramirez's confession was ruled inadmissible because it implicated Butler, who had admitted to nothing. Finally, Ramirez was found innocent, and Butler guilty only of kidnapping Renee's daughter and roommate, Kimbra; he was not convicted of kidnapping Michelle Renee. Two months later, Huggins and Ortiz went on trial, and were found guilty of all charges, including the kidnapping of Michelle Renee. The trio, known as the West Memphis Three, were convicted of triple-murder: Misskelley and Baldwin sentenced to life in prison, while Damien Echols received the death penalty. The police had no evidence linking Echols to the crime until Misskelley, whose lawyer says he has the mental capabilities of a five-year-old and barely knew Echols, confessed to helping him and Jason Baldwin commit the murders -- although many of the facts he recounted about the crime were incorrect. Misskelley was tried first, convicted and sentenced. Echols and Baldwin went on trial together: Misskelley refused to testify against them, and by law his confession could not be used against them. Still, they were convicted. As word of this case spread, so did the outrage over what many believed was a grave injustice. Members of the entertainment community, including actor Johnny Depp and musicians Natalie Maines and Eddie Vedder, came to their support. An HBO documentary, "Paradise Lost", and a book by Mara Leveritt entitled "Devil's Knot", detailed flaws in the case and now, forensic scientists have challenged the causes of the wounds inflicted on the victims, and sworn affidavits have revealed possible jury misconduct and new DNA evidence points away from the three convicted men and towards someone unexpected -- Terry Hobbs, Steve Branch's step-father at the time of the murders. As Echols prepares to take his case to federal court, he has some unexpected support from the parents of two of the victims: Mark Byers and Pam Branch, who now agree that justice has not been served. In addition, the Floyds, who wanted to move out of Kansas, had been told that, if they left the state, Shannon would probably lose custody of Mikey to his father. Five days after his disappearance, Mike's truck was found in a remote field, but with no evidence of foul play. Police investigation of the Floyd's home revealed small amounts of blood and Mike Golub's DNA on the unpainted underside of their newly repainted front deck. Other circumstantial evidence also made police suspicious of the Floyds. In 2006, Shannon and Chad Floyd were arrested and charged with Mike's murder; Chad's father posted their \$2 million bond bail. In 2007, they were tried -- but the jury declared itself deadlocked after two days of deliberations. Prosecutors re-filed the charges, and in April 2008, there was a second trial -- and, once again, the jury declared itself deadlocked, after two days of deliberations. Prosecutors ultimately decided against a third trial, fearing another hung jury. The Floyds went free, and Mike Golub is officially still missing. Police found her car at Theresa and Sam's house, but there was no sign of her and no obvious signs of foul play. Police investigation revealed that Sam was an abusive husband with a drinking problem. When investigators found vacuum marks, Theresa's blood and Sam Parker's DNA in the back of Theresa's SUV, he was arrested and charged with his wife's murder. Prosecutors believed that Sam had murdered Theresa, drove off and disposed of her body. Parker insisted he had not killed his wife and suspected that she had run off to Mexico. The jurors said the task of deciding Sam Parker's fate was particularly daunting because they had an overwhelming amount of circumstantial evidence, but not much else. After three days of deliberation, the jurors seemed hopelessly deadlocked. The judge urged them to give it one more try. After a closer look at cell phone records, the jury found him guilty of first-degree murder. He was immediately sentenced to life in prison. Theresa's family believes that Parker may be the only one who holds the key to

finding Theresa's body, but he still insists that he did not kill her and does not know where she is. Koulis, a plastic surgeon, had called 911 when she stopped breathing, and said he performed CPR, but that there was no pulse. When Lesa was rushed to the emergency room, the doctors trying to save her life said Dr. Koulis told them nothing about the drugs she had been using -- information that could have been crucial in saving her life. With Lesa dead, investigators quickly focused on drugs. At her apartment, detectives discovered used syringes with traces of oxycodone -- a powerful narcotic used to kill pain and available only from a prescribing physician. After a five month investigation, Dr. Koulis was arrested on four charges -- ranging from simple assault to second degree murder. At the trial, prosecutors alleged Dr. Koulis had injected Lesa with oxycodone during the course of the weekend, which eventually led to her death. But the defense claimed Lesa injected herself, and that she had a drug problem - a claim her family and investigators disputed. Ultimately, Dr. Koulis was found guilty of criminally negligent homicide. He will likely remain free until 2009, pending his appeal. **08/21/10 Update:** Five years after Lesa Buchanan's death, and with his appeal still pending, Christ Koulis was found dead at a friend's apartment. Toxicology reports state the cause of death as bronchial pneumonia due to opiate intoxication, a drug overdose. Because his case was in appeal, his attorney David Raybin was able get his 2007 conviction dropped by the state's Court of Criminal Appeals. However, the attorney general's office is fighting to have that conviction reinstated. Koulis' attorney feels the conviction should be vacated.
